Night of A Thousand Dinners (N1KD) is an event that helps to raise awareness of the global landmine crisis and to raise funds for mine action. N1KD began as a global campaign in 2001 and the tradition continues to this day among Rotary Clubs in Canada.

Rotarians and Rotary Clubs have been two of the largest financial contributors to the Canadian Landmine Foundation. 122 Clubs in 18 Districts coast to coast have contributed more than \$260,000 to Canadian Landmine Foundation programmes that cleared mines and assisted victims in places like Bosnia, Mozambique, Afghanistan and Cambodia.
